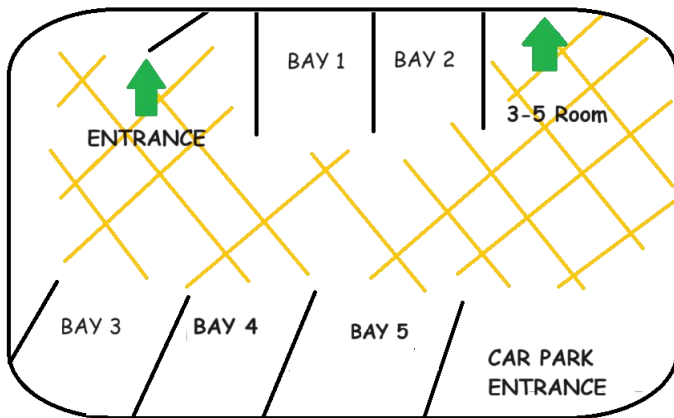
As we reach the last half term of this school year we want to keep you informed and updated of what's happening in Treehouse this term.
